

General Season Landowner Buck Deer Permits

Qualifying applications must be received between March 1 and March 31

Landowner buck tags will now be awarded through a drawing. All lands must be in agricultural use as provided in Utah Code Section 59-2-502 and 503 (Greenbelt status). **Permits are capped at a maximum of five (5) per landowner.** If there are remaining permits they will be available on a first come, first served basis.

Landowners can qualify for the drawing in two different ways.

1. One permit for each 640 acres of private land that provides habitat for deer.
2. A max of one permit for 100 acres of cropland that is used by migratory deer and substantially contributes to the deer herd.

Qualifying applications must be received between March 1 and March 31 at the regional office where the qualifying land is located. **We encourage you to submit your application electronically to the appropriate regional email address listed below.** *No late applications will be accepted.*

Once an application is reviewed and approved, landowners will receive an email indicating the number of permits they can apply for in the drawing. A \$10 handling fee for each permit applied for must be collected prior to June 5 or the application will not be included in the drawing. Drawing results will be posted by July 1. Those successful in the drawing will be issued vouchers to redeem for permits. Everyone is encouraged to put in for the regular draw to increase chances of obtaining a deer permit.

Permits are only available to landowners and lessees, and their immediate family members. Immediate family is defined as the landowner's or lessee's spouse, children, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, father, mother, father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother, sister, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, stepchildren, and grandchildren.

Any parcel of private land may only be considered once. *If multiple applications for the same parcel are submitted, all applications for that parcel will be rejected.*

Once the application is complete, please submit it to the appropriate Division office where the qualifying land exists by March 31. If unsure of the region, please contact any office for assistance.

Please be sure it includes:

- The appropriate section of this form filled in completely
- Signatures of all landowners or lessees having an interest in the eligible property. If a lessee is applying for general landowner permits, a copy of the lease agreement is also required
- A digital map of the property indicating the county and general season deer unit it is located in (contact your regional office for assistance).
- You may be asked to supply tax notices as proof of ownership
